Application Process for ISEP

1 Before Applying



Participate in GEO's <u>Study Abroad Fair</u> **'** in January.

Research partner universities and destination countries. Be prepared to cover housing and living expenses, airfare, visa fees, textbooks and other miscellaneous expenses.

Assess your eligibility* for ISEP.

Attend GEO's ISEP Application Briefing.

*To be eligible for ISEP, you are required to

- Not be in your final term of study during exchange.
- Have completed at least two terms of studies (LKCSB, SOA, SOE, SOSS and JD students) or four terms of studies (SCIS and LLB students) in SMU.
- Have achieved at least 8 CUs (LKCSB, SOA, SOE, SOSS and JD students) or 16 CUs (SCIS and LLB students) in SMU.
- Have attained a GPA of 2.0 and above (3.0 and above for YPHSL students).
