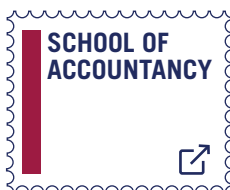

Based on course enrolment result in Fall 2022 term



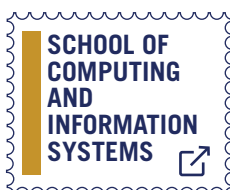

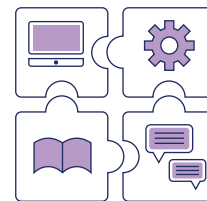
International Student Exchange Programme (ISEP) [↗](#)

Fall Term: Mid-August — Early December
Spring Term: Early January — Early May

Eligibility

- ✓ Completed at least one academic year of undergraduate studies
- ✓ Continue to be a registered undergraduate in their home university throughout the period of study at SMU
- ✓ Fulfil the English language proficiency requirement by SMU

ISEP: Only applicable to students who are officially nominated by their home university

VSP: Students must have obtained a cGPA of 3.0 out of 4.0, or equivalent
